## THE DAY OF SHAKING: A PROPHETIC WARNING

We live in a day of shaking — a holy convulsion by which God will separate what is true from what is counterfeit. The shaking comes by the power of the Holy Ghost to expose that which is built on man: charisma, personality, showmanship, professionalism, pride, and compromise. Many denominations and ministries that have relied on reputation, programs, entertainment, and ecumenical compromise are on life support. The Lord is preparing to let them flatline so that only what is built on the Rock will remain.

This shaking is not destruction for its own sake but purification. Babylon — the spirit of religious compromise and counterfeit Christianity — will fall. From that shaking, God will birth a holy, powerful, apostolic Bride: a people baptized in the Name of Jesus and filled with the Holy Ghost, speaking with other tongues.

## BABYLON'S COLLAPSE: IDENTIFYING THE COUNTERFEIT

The counterfeit is marked by:

- Reliance on personality and charisma rather than Christ.
- Showmanship, entertainment, and professional polish over repentance and holiness.
- Compromise with the world in doctrine, morals, and ecumenical alliances.
- Leadership built on self-glory rather than servanthood and apostolic authority.

Scripture warns about false shepherds and false prophets (Jeremiah 23; Matthew 7:15; 2 Peter 2). The shaking purifies the Bride by removing these false foundations. Do not love the things God is removing; instead seek the true and enduring.

## THE BIRTH AND IDENTITY OF THE TRUE CHURCH

The true Church was birthed on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2). That birth was characterized by:

- Repentance and baptism (Acts 2:38).
- The outpouring of the Holy Ghost (Acts 2:1–4).
- Apostolic preaching and authority (Acts 2–28).

The Apostolic Pentecostal Church stands on the

biblical pattern: salvation through Jesus Christ, water baptism in the Name of Jesus for the remission of sins, and the baptism of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in other tongues. This is not a tradition invented by men but the New Testament pattern — the New Loaf, the New Testament testimony — the true Israel of God (Romans 9–11; Galatians 6:16).

## BAPTISM IN JESUS' NAME AND THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY GHOST

Central doctrines:

- Baptism in Jesus' name: Following the apostolic command, those who repent must be baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; Acts 8:16; Acts 10:48; Acts 19:5). This is an act of identification with Christ's death, burial, and resurrection (Romans 6:3–4).
- Baptism of the Holy Ghost: The gift promised by the Father is received by those who repent and believe; its initial physical evidence in the apostolic age and in Pentecostal experience is speaking in other tongues (Acts 2:4; Acts 10:44–46; Acts 19:6). Tongues function as the sign of sonship and the sealing by the Spirit (Romans 8; Galatians 4).
- Holiness and sanctification: The Spirit's presence

purifies, sanctifies, and separates a people unto God (1 Thessalonians 4:3–8; Hebrews 12).

## THE THIRD PULL: AN END-TIME OUTPOURING AND EXODUS

The “third pull” is the coming outpouring of the Holy Ghost in power beyond what has been seen — a massive revival and cleansing of the temple of the Holy Ghost (the Bride, the body of Christ). When the Spirit moves mightily:

- There will be an Exodus of souls from counterfeit systems into the apostolic, Jesus-name Church.
- A purification will occur: a separation of wheat from chaff, sheep from goats.
- The Bride will be prepared — without spot, wrinkle, or blemish (Ephesians 5:27).

This movement will call people to repentance, baptism in Jesus’ Name, and to live by the power of the Holy Ghost. Seek this power now; do not wait for a future sign when your heart is not right with God.

## TRIBULATION, RAPTURE, AND THE RETURN OF CHRIST

From an Apostolic Pentecostal perspective presented here:

- The Church will experience intense trials and will be purified — now and through the tribulation.
- The rapture will occur after the Great Tribulation for the elect (a post-tribulation understanding).

Scripture points to a time of testing followed by the appearing of the Lord and the catching up of His people (Matthew 24; 1 Thessalonians 4–5; Revelation 7, 14, 19).

- At Christ's return, the Church (the true Israel of God) will be with Him in victory (Revelation 19) and will reign with Him (Revelation 20–22).

Israel, as a nation, will encounter the Messiah in the tribulation, repent, and many will be grafted into the saving work of Christ (Romans 11; Revelation 7, 14). The Church — the blood-washed, Jesus-name, Spirit-filled Bride — will stand with Christ and participate in the final overthrow of evil at Armageddon.

## PRACTICAL STEPS OF REPENTANCE AND PREPARATION

If you hear the voice of the Lord in this hour, respond now:

- Search your heart: Confess and forsake sin (Psalm 139; 1 John 1:9).
- Repent: Genuine turning from sin and turning to Jesus (Acts 2:38).
- Be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; Romans 6:3–4).
- Seek and receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues (Acts 2:4; Acts 10:44–46).
- Pursue holiness: live separated from the world’s moral and spiritual compromises (1 Peter 1:15–16).
- Become active in a local, apostolic body that preaches the New Testament message and practice.

## WORSHIP, BAPTISMAL ORDER, AND PRAYER FOR THE INFILLING

A simple baptismal order:

1. Preaching the Gospel and call to repentance (Acts 2:37–38).
2. Confession of faith in Jesus Christ.
3. Immersion in water in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 6:4; Acts 2:38).
4. Laying on of hands and prayer for the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues (Acts 8:14–17; Acts 19:6).
5. Expectancy for tongues, prophecy, and other gifts

of the Spirit (1 Corinthians 12–14).

A brief prayer for the infilling of the Holy Ghost the evidence of speaking in tongues:

“Lord Jesus, I repent, I turn from my sin. I believe You are Lord and Savior. I ask for baptism in Your Name for the remission of my sins. Fill me with the Holy Ghost and fire. Give me the gift of tongues is the sign of Your Spirit. Cleanse me, empower me, and make me ready for Your coming. In Jesus’ Name. Amen.”

### CONCLUSION: THE BRIDE MADE READY

The hour is urgent. God is shaking religious systems, exposing counterfeit glory, and preparing a Bride fit for the Bridegroom. The Apostolic Pentecostal witness — repentance, baptism in Jesus’ Name, and the baptism of the Holy Ghost with tongues — stands as the scriptural, apostolic remedy for a world in chaos. Prepare your heart now. Be baptized, be filled, be sanctified, and stand holy and uncompromised. The King is coming. Let us be ready.
