Introduction

The Scriptures speak with one steady voice: God has revealed Himself to mankind in the person and name of the Lord Jesus Christ. From prophecy to fulfillment, the Bible shows the invisible God made visible in Jesus of Nazareth. My booklet sets forth that

revelation in a Oneness Apostolic Pentecostal manner: God is one undivided Deity revealed in Jesus Christ; the Name by which men are born of water and spirit, baptized in water in Jesus Name and The Baptism in the Holy Ghost and fire with the evidence of speaking in tongues you receive the Holy Ghost in Jesus Name is the Name of the Holy Ghost John 14:26, and empowered for ministry is the Lord Jesus Christ.

God Revealed in the Name of Jesus (Oneness Apostolic Understanding)

Oneness Apostolic faith confesses that the one God — who is Jesus is the Father, Jesus is the Son, and Jesus is the Holy Ghost Jesus is the one divine name of God — He has revealed Himself supremely and uniquely in the flesh is the Lord Jesus Christ. The power is in the one Name: The Lord Jesus Christ.

This is not a denial of the biblical revelation of The bible is clear Jesus is the Father, Jesus is the Son, and Jesus is the Holy Ghost; it is the clear claim that these are not three separate gods but they are titles of one God manifest in one person in the Lord Jesus Christ, and that the personal, redemptive revelation of God to humanity is the Lord Jesus Christ. The Name "Jesus" is therefore the Name of salvation, of prayer, of baptism, of authority and of the Spirit's power.

Scriptural Witnesses (selected references)

The Bible points to Jesus as God manifest in the flesh and as the divine Name to be called upon:

- The prophecy of Immanuel (God with us): Isaiah 7:14; fulfilled in Matthew 1:21–23.
- The messianic titles: "Mighty God...Everlasting Father...Prince of Peace": Isaiah 9:6.
- The eternal Word made flesh: John 1:1–14 the Word who was God became flesh and dwelt among us.
- God revealed by name in covenant history and fully revealed in Christ: Exodus 6:3; see the New Testament revelation in John 3:18.
- The Damascus road: Saul hears the voice of the Lord Jesus (Acts 9:4–14).
- The preaching of the apostles: "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved" (Acts 16:31); "Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Acts 2:21); "Confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus" (Romans 10:9).
- Peter's sermon: God hath made Him both Lord and Christ (Acts 2:36).

These passages show a consistent New Testament pattern: the Lord Jesus Christ is the divine Name by which men are to come to God.

The Name: How We Live It — Prayer, Baptism, Ministry

The revelation of the Divine Name is practical and public. The early church lived out the Name of Jesus in clear patterns:

• Prayer: We pray in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus taught that prayer is to be offered in His Name, and the apostles prayed and healed invoking that Name (John 14:13–14; Acts 4:7–12).

- Confession and Faith: Salvation is by confessing Jesus as Lord and believing in His resurrection (Romans 10:9–10). This confession is both an intellectual and an allegiance confession Jesus is God and my Lord.
- Baptism: The New Testament records baptism in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ (Acts 2:38; Acts 8:16; Acts 10:48; Acts 19:5).
 Baptism in Jesus' Name unites the believer with Christ's death, burial and resurrection and publicly links the believer to the Divine Name that sayes.
- The Holy Ghost: The Spirit is given in conjunction with faith in Jesus and is received as the promise of the Father. The Spirit's work continues the revelation and power of Jesus (Acts 2; Acts 10:44–48).
- Healing, deliverance, authority: The apostles cast out demons, healed the sick, and exercised spiritual authority in the Name of Jesus (Acts 3; Acts 4; Matt. 18:18–20).
- Preaching and teaching: The gospel is proclaimed in Jesus' Name; ministry is carried on under His authority (Matt. 28:18–20; Col. 3:17).

1. The Church and the Name

The New Testament church gathered, worshiped, and exercised ministry in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. When believers assemble in His Name, they recognize His presence and authority among them (Matt. 18:18–20). The church's foundation is the Lord Jesus Christ (Matt. 16:18–20; 1 Cor. 3:10–11). A Jesus-Name assembly is not merely a label: it is a confession of God's revelation and a commitment to the New Testament pattern of calling upon the Lord Jesus.

2. Invitation — How to Receive the Lord Jesus Christ

Salvation in the New Testament is simple and immediate for those who believe and call upon the Name:

- 3. Confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus.
- 4. Believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead (Romans 10:9–10).
- 5. Call upon His Name for salvation (Acts 2:21).
- 6. Be baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; see Acts 8:16; Acts 10:48; Acts 19:5).
- 7. Seek the gift of the Holy Ghost (Acts 2:38; Acts 10:44–48).

Sample prayer:

"Lord Jesus, I believe You are God manifested in the flesh. I confess You as Lord. Forgive my sins. Come into my life. I trust in Your Name for salvation. In the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ, amen."

If you have prayed this prayer sincerely, seek baptism in Jesus' Name and fellowship with a Jesus-Name assembly. Ask for the laying on of hands and the gift of the Holy Ghost as recorded in the New Testament.
