Activate Your Faith in Him

Faith Brings Assurance and Confidence Hebrews 10:19-22 “Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings...”

6. Jesus Provides Access to the Father By activating our faith in Jesus, we gain direct access to God, who hears our prayers and responds to our needs.
