Attributes of Jesus with Scriptures

1. Love - Unconditional love for all. John 13:34-35 - “A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.”

Hebrew

1. Rooted

- Hebrew Word: שָׂרַשׁ (sharash)
- Meaning: This word refers to the act of putting down roots, establishing a firm foundation, or being deeply embedded. In a biblical context, it often relates to being established in faith or righteousness.
- Example: Jeremiah 17:8 - “They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream.”

2. Grounded

- Hebrew Word: יָסַד (yasad)
- Meaning: This term means to establish, lay a foundation, or set something firmly. It conveys the idea of being firmly established or rooted in something.
- Example: Psalm 104:5 - “The Lord established the earth upon its foundations, so it will never move.”

Greek

1. Rooted

- Greek Word: ῥιζόω (rhizoo)
- Meaning: This verb means to cause to take root, to establish deeply, or to be firmly rooted. In a spiritual context, it often refers to being firmly established in faith or love.
- Example: Colossians 2:7 - “Rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith...”

2. Grounded

- Greek Word: θεμελιόω (themelioo)
- Meaning: This word means to lay a foundation, to establish, or to make firm. It implies a strong and secure base, often in relation to faith or doctrine.
- Example: Ephesians 3:17 - “That Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love...”

Summary

- In Hebrew, rooted (שָׂרַשׁ, sharash) emphasizes being firmly embedded, while grounded (יָסַד, yasad) focuses on being established or laid down securely.
- In Greek, rooted (ῥιζόω, rhizoo) conveys a sense of deep establishment, and grounded (θεμελιόω, themelioo) emphasizes laying a firm foundation.

These terms are often used metaphorically in the Bible to describe a believer's relationship with

God, emphasizing the importance of being firmly established in faith and love.

2. Compassion - Deep empathy for the suffering of others. Matthew 9:36 - “When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.”

3. Forgiveness - Willingness to forgive sins. Luke 23:34 - “Jesus said, ‘Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.’”

4. Humility - Servant leadership and humility. Philippians 2:5-7 - “In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant.”

5. Patience - Endurance in the face of trials. James 1:2-4 - “Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds...”

6. Kindness - Gentle and considerate behavior. Ephesians 4:32 - “Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.”

7. Gentleness - Meekness and softness in demeanor. Matthew 11:29 - "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart..."

8. Self-Control - Mastery over desires and impulses. Galatians 5:22-23 - "But the fruit of the Spirit is ... self-control."

9. Faithfulness - Loyalty and reliability. Revelation 19:11 - "Faithful and true is he who rides on the white horse."

10. Truthfulness - Commitment to truth. John 14:6 - "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life.'"

11. Integrity - Wholeness and moral uprightness. Proverbs 10:9 - "Whoever walks in integrity walks securely..."

12. Joy - Inner peace and happiness. John 15:11 - "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete."

13. Peace - Bringing calmness and harmony. John 14:27 - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you."

14. Righteousness - Commitment to what is right and just. Matthew 5:6 - "Blessed are those who hunger and

thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.”

15. Obedience - Submission to God’s will. John 6:38 - “For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me.”

16. Servanthood - Willingness to serve others. Mark 10:45 - “For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve...”

17. Generosity - Giving freely without expecting anything in return. 2 Corinthians 9:7 - “Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion...”

18. Courage - Boldness in the face of adversity. John 16:33 - “In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

19. Wisdom - Deep understanding and insight. Luke 2:52 - “And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.”

20. Discipleship - Commitment to teaching and mentoring. Matthew 28:19-20 - “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations...”

21. Prayerfulness - Dedication to prayer and communication with God. Luke 5:16 - “But Jesus often

withdrew to lonely places and prayed.”

22. Compassionate Listening - Attentiveness to others' needs and concerns. James 1:19 - “Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.”

23. Graciousness - Showing grace and favor to others. Colossians 4:6 - “Let your conversation be always full of grace...”

24. Sincerity - Authenticity in words and actions. Romans 12:9 - “Love must be sincere...”

25. Inclusiveness - Welcoming all, regardless of background. Galatians 3:28 - “There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.”

26. Faith - Trust in God's promises. Hebrews 11:1 - “Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.”

27. Hope - Assurance of God's goodness and future. Romans 15:13 - “May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him...”

28. Simplicity - Focus on what truly matters. Matthew 6:33 - “But seek first his kingdom and his

righteousness...”

29. Boldness - Speaking the truth fearlessly. Acts 4:29 - “Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness.”

30. Sacrifice - Willingness to give up personal gain for others. John 15:13 - “Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.”

31. Vision - Clear understanding of God’s purpose. Proverbs 29:18 - “Where there is no vision, the people perish...”

32. Justice - Advocacy for the oppressed. Isaiah 1:17 - “Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed.”

33. Mercy - Compassionate treatment of those in need. Matthew 5:7 - “Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.”

34. Reconciliation - Restoring relationships. 2 Corinthians 5:18 - “All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ...”

35. Teaching - Sharing wisdom and knowledge. Matthew 28:20 - “Teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.”

36. Encouragement - Uplifting and motivating others.1
Thessalonians 5:11 - "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up..."

37. Faithfulness in Prayer - Commitment to intercession.Romans 12:12 - "Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."

38. Gratitude - Thankfulness in all circumstances.1
Thessalonians 5:18 - "Give thanks in all circumstances..."

39. Selflessness - Putting others before oneself.
Philippians 2:3 - "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit..."

40. Humor - Joyful spirit and light-heartedness.
Proverbs 17:22 - "A cheerful heart is good medicine..."

41. Understanding - Insight into human nature.
Proverbs 4:7 - "The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding."

42. Perseverance - Steadfastness in trials.Romans 5:3-4 - "Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance..."

43. Non-judgmental - Acceptance without condemnation. Matthew 7:1 - “Do not judge, or you too will be judged.”

44. Visionary - Looking beyond the present to future possibilities. Jeremiah 29:11 - “For I know the plans I have for you...”

45. Empathy - Ability to understand and share feelings. Romans 12:15 - “Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.”

46. Diligence - Hard work and commitment to tasks. Proverbs 13:4 - “The soul of the sluggard craves and gets nothing, while the soul of the diligent is richly supplied.”

47. Loyalty - Faithfulness to friends and followers. Proverbs 17:17 - “A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity.”

48. Respect - Valuing others as individuals. 1 Peter 2:17 - “Show proper respect to everyone...”

49. Spirituality - Deep connection with God. John 4:24 - “God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.”

50. Awareness - Sensitivity to the needs of others.

Philippians 2:4 - “Not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.”

51. Celebration - Joy in life's moments.Ecclesiastes 3:4 - “A time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance.”

52. Supportiveness - Being there for others.Galatians 6:2 - “Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.”

53. Adaptability - Flexibility in changing circumstances.1 Corinthians 9:22 - “I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some.”

54. Discernment - Ability to judge well.Philippians 1:9-10 - “And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight...”

55. Vision for Community - Building and nurturing community.Acts 2:44-47 - “All the believers were together and had everything in common...”

56. Non-resistance - Responding to aggression with love.Matthew 5:39 - “But I tell you, do not resist an evil person...”

57. Faith in Action - Living out beliefs through deeds.
James 2:17 - "In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead."

58. Hopefulness - Maintaining a positive outlook.
Romans 15:13 - "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him..."

59. Transparency - Openness in relationships.²
Corinthians 4:2 - "We have renounced secret and shameful ways; we do not use deception..."

60. Devotion - Deep commitment to God. Matthew
22:37 - "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."

61. Friendliness - Approachability and warmth.
Proverbs 18:24 - "A man who has friends must himself be friendly..."

62. Authenticity - Being true to oneself.² Corinthians
1:12 - "Our conscience testifies that we have conducted ourselves in the world...with integrity and godly sincerity."

63. Charity - Generosity toward the less fortunate.¹
John 3:17 - "If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person?"

64. Listening - Attentive to others' stories. Proverbs 18:13 - "To answer before listening—that is folly and shame."

65. Vision of Unity - Promoting harmony among diverse groups. Ephesians 4:3 - "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."

66. Caring - Taking time to show concern. 1 Peter 5:7 - "Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you."

67. Nurturing - Supporting growth in others. 1 Thessalonians 2:7 - "But we were gentle among you, like a mother caring for her little children."

68. Faith in God's Plan - Trusting in divine providence. Proverbs 3:5-6 - "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding..."

69. Restorative - Seeking to heal and restore. Galatians 6:1 - "Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently."

70. Celebration of Diversity - Appreciating different cultures and backgrounds. Revelation 7:9 - "After this

73. Fellowship - Building relationships with others. Hebrews 10:24-25 - “And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds...”

74. Teaching by Example - Living out His teachings. 1 Timothy 4:12 - “Set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.”

75. Divine Authority - Understanding His role as the Son of God. Matthew 28:18 - “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.”

76. Simplicity in Faith - Trusting God with childlike faith. Matthew 18:3 - “And he said: ‘Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children,

you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.”

77. Caring for Creation - Respecting the environment.
Genesis 2:15 - “The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.”

78. Mentorship - Guiding others in their spiritual journeys.2 Timothy 2:2 - “And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.”

79. Awareness of Spiritual Warfare - Understanding the battle against evil.Ephesians 6:12 - “For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world...”

80. Celebration of Life - Embracing the joy of living.
Psalm 118:24 - “This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.”

81. Emotional Intelligence - Understanding and managing emotions.Proverbs 14:29 - “Whoever is patient has great understanding, but one who is quick-tempered displays folly.”

82. Being Present - Fully engaging with those around

Him. Matthew 6:34 - “Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself.”
