### Foreword and Purpose

This booklet is prepared for Pastors and local church pulpits to equip saints to detect, resist, and break free from seducing spirits that seek to strip believers of the anointing. It upholds Apostolic Pentecostal convictions: water baptism in Jesus' Name, the infilling of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues, holiness of life, and the authority Christ gave the Church to bind and loose, to cast out demons, and to restore the lost anointing.

### Scripture Readings (for opening worship)

- Revelation 2:18–29 (the letter to Thyatira — the Jezebel warning)
- 1 Timothy 4:1–2 (seducing spirits and doctrines of devils)
- Romans 8:9; Acts 1:4–8; Acts 2:1–4 (the Holy Ghost as witness and power)
- John 3:3–8; Acts 2:39 (new birth and promise)
- Mark 16:17; Luke 10:19; Matthew 16:18–19; Matthew 18:18–20 (authority)

## Memory Verses

- Acts 1:8 — “But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you...”
- Revelation 2:20 — “Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee... because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel... to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication...”

### Sermon Outline — “The Anointing Under Attack”

#### Introduction (3–5 minutes)

- Open with prayer asking for discernment.
- Briefly explain Apostolic convictions: new birth, baptism in Jesus’ Name, infilling of the Holy Ghost with tongues.
- State thesis: There is an active spiritual attack (the spirit of Jezebel and related seducing spirits) aimed at stealing the anointing. The Church has the authority and tools to resist, recover, and remain anointed.

Point 1 — Know the Enemy: Recognize the Jezebel Strategy (8–10 minutes)

Scripture: Revelation 2:18–29; 1 Timothy 4:1–2

Description:

- Jezebel spirit is a seducing, controlling spirit that leads into compromise, doctrinal error, and spiritual immorality.
- It targets the anointing — the evidence of God’s presence in a believer’s life — by seducing, accusing, and tempting through false teaching and compromise.

#### Signs:

- Teaching that minimizes the need for the Holy Ghost or the evidence of tongues.
- Pressure to compromise holiness (moral, doctrinal, or ecclesiastical).
- Intimidation, control, or manipulative leadership that resists accountability and repentance.

#### Application:

- Test teachings by Scripture (1 John 4:1). Beware of anything that diminishes Christ’s standards or the baptism of the Holy Ghost.

Point 2 — Resist and Rebuke: The Authority Given to Us (8–10 minutes)

Scripture: Luke 10:19; Mark 16:17; Matthew 16:18–19; Matthew 18:18–20

#### Teaching:

- We have authority in Jesus’ Name to bind demonic influences and loose God’s truth.

- Spiritual warfare is not optional; it is part of the Church's vocation.

Practical steps:

- Discernment through prayer and the gift of discerning spirits (1 Corinthians 12:10; Romans 8:16–27).
- Speak the Word and use the Name of Jesus to rebuke and bind.
- Use corporate authority: two or three gathered in Christ's Name have power.

Point 3 — Recover the Anointing: Steps to Restoration (10–12 minutes)

Scripture: Acts 2; Acts 8:12–20 (Simon the sorcerer); Romans 8:9–11

Steps:

1. Confession and Repentance — personal and corporate (1 John 1:9).
2. Renunciation — verbally renounce ungodly agreements, false teachings, and spirit influences tied to Jezebel.
3. Rebuke — in Jesus' Name, command the spirit to leave. Pastors lead; the congregation participates with faith.
4. Fill with the Holy Ghost — ask for the baptism of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in

tongues (Acts 1:4–8, Acts 2:1–4).

5. Water baptism in Jesus' Name (Acts 2:38) where appropriate as testimony of faith.

6. Discipleship and accountability — place new or restored believers under shepherding and teaching.

Illustration:

Simon the sorcerer: repentance is required; the Holy Ghost and power are not bought (Acts 8:9–24).

Point 4 — Reignite the Fire: Living Continually in the Spirit (8–10 minutes)

Scripture: Galatians 5:16–25; Zechariah 4:6; Romans 8:9–11

Living Instructions:

- Walk in the Spirit daily — cultivate prayer, praise, Scripture, and fellowship.
- Keep the altar hot — maintain times of personal consecration and corporate revival.
- Exercise spiritual gifts: prophecy, tongues, discerning, healing with humility and order (1 Corinthians 12–14).
- Use the keys of the kingdom to bind what is wicked and loose what is righteous.

Warning:

A one-time encounter without ongoing obedience and

discipleship leaves one vulnerable. Maintain intimacy.

## Conclusion and Altar Call (5–7 minutes)

- Summarize the four points.
- Call for a corporate response: repentance, renunciation, prayer for infilling, and personal commitment to accountability.
- Lead into a structured altar time: confession (silent and then corporate), renunciation aloud, corporate rebuke of Jezebel spirit, invitation to receive the Holy Ghost, and directed prayer to speak in tongues.

## Full Sermon Text (Pulpit Version)

### Opening

- Scripture reading: Revelation 2:18–29.
- Prayer: “Heavenly Father, send the Spirit of truth. Grant us eyes to see and ears to hear. Let the anointing fall. In Jesus’ Name, amen.”

### Introductory Remarks

“Brothers and sisters, the church in Thyatira was

seduced by a woman called Jezebel. That letter from Christ is not only for an ancient church. The same spirit operates today. It seeks to seduce God's people away from holiness and the fullness of the Holy Ghost. Today we will learn to recognize that spirit, resist it with the authority Christ has given us, recover what was stolen, and live in the power of the Spirit."

Corporate Deliverance Prayer Litany  
(Leader's Script)

Leader: "If there is anyone here who has been robbed of their anointing, who has agreed with false doctrine, or who has opened a door to seducing spirits, step forward now in your heart. If you need to come forward, come now."

1. Confession

Leader: "Let us confess out loud: 'I confess my sin. I repent of every compromise. I repent of every agreement with Jezebel spirit. I renounce every lie that downplays the need for the Holy Ghost.'"

2. Renunciation

Leader: "By the authority of Jesus Christ, I renounce every ungodly vow, every alliance with false teaching, every marriage to spirit influences. I break every spiritual tie to Jezebel and her devices."

### 3. Rebuke

Leader: “In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I command the spirit of Jezebel and every seducing spirit to come out of this life, this house, this mind. Leave now — in Jesus’ Name!”

All: (Join by faith and voice)

### 4. Filling

Leader: “Repentant ones, lift your hands — ask the Father for the Holy Ghost. Expect to receive. If you are hungry, pray: ‘Holy Ghost, fall on me now; speak through me; fill me; give me the evidence of speaking in tongues.’”

Provide quiet time for people to receive and manifest tongues.

### 1. Seal and Discipleship

Leader: “If you have just been filled, come to the front so we can pray with you and connect you with a minister for follow-up and water baptism in Jesus’ Name.”

## Prayer Prompts & Declarations (for leader or members)

- “Heavenly Father, cleanse me. Fill me. Restore my first love. Give me discernment to detect seducing

spirits.”

- “In Jesus’ Name I bind every spirit of control, manipulation, and seduction. I loose the pure anointing and the boldness to testify.”
- “I receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost and expect to speak with other tongues as the Spirit gives utterance.”

### Suggested Worship Songs / Hymns

- “Holy Ghost” (chorus-based worship)
- “Breathe On Me, Breath of God” (consecration)
- “Refiner’s Fire” (purity)
- Spirit-filled choruses emphasizing baptism in Jesus’ Name and the Holy Ghost

### Small-Group / Follow-up Questions

1. What are the clear signs in our lives or in the church that indicate a seducing spirit is at work?
2. What ungodly agreements or compromises must we renounce personally and corporately?
3. Have you received the baptism of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues? If not, what steps can you take this week?
4. Who will be your accountability partner?
5. What practical disciplines will you adopt to “walk in the Spirit”?

## Pastoral Notes and Cautions

- Deliverance and spiritual warfare must be pastoral and pastoral-led. Avoid theatrical displays; keep mercy, biblical boundaries, and follow-up counseling.
- Not every problem is demonic; pastoral discernment is essential. Encourage medical or psychological help when appropriate.
- Simon the sorcerer (Acts 8) is a warning: repentance must be sincere, and the gifts/power of God are not for sale. Teach stewardship, holiness, and service.
- This booklet is a tool; continue one-on-one discipleship for those who respond at the altar.
