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Preface

This booklet is a clarion call to the true Church—the Apostolic Pentecostal, Holy Ghost-filled, Jesus Name, tongue-talking body of believers. We are living in the final hour, and the wind of the Spirit is blowing again.

This is not a denominational wind.

This is not a man-made movement.

This is the same wind that blew on the Day of Pentecost.

The wind is blowing in our direction.

Chapter 1: The Sound of a Mighty Rushing Wind

Text: Acts 2:1–4

“And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind...”

The Church was not born in silence—it was born in power. The initial outpouring of the Holy Ghost was accompanied by:

- A sound from heaven
- A mighty rushing wind

- Cloven tongues like as of fire
- Speaking in other tongues

This wind represents the supernatural operation of God Himself. It was not symbolic—it was experiential. The wind filled the house, and then it filled the people.

The Apostolic Church is not built on tradition—it is built on experience.

And that same wind is blowing again.

Chapter 2: The Wind of the Spirit – A Divine Mystery

Text: John 3:8

“The wind bloweth where it listeth... so is every one that is born of the Spirit.”

Jesus revealed that the new birth is like the wind:

- You hear it (audible evidence)
- You feel it (experiential reality)
- You see its effects (transformation)

The Holy Ghost is not a silent conversion—it is a

Chapter 3: The Apostolic Pattern – Acts 2:38

Text: Acts 2:38

Acts 2:38 is the doorway into the Kingdom of God.

Chapter 4: The Name Above Every Name

Text: Acts 4:12

“Neither is there salvation in any other...”

The power is in the Name:

JESUS

- Not titles
- Not formulas
- Not traditions

The Apostles always baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ because:

- Jesus is the Father
- Jesus is the Son
- Jesus is the Holy Ghost

God is not three persons—God is ONE.

“God was manifest in the flesh” (1 Timothy 3:16)

Jesus Christ is Almighty God revealed to humanity.

Chapter 5: The Wind Carries Power and Dominion

Text: Luke 10:19

“Behold, I give unto you power... over all the power of the enemy...”

When the wind of the Holy Ghost is blowing:

- Devils are cast out
- Sickness is healed
- Bondages are broken
- Authority is restored

This is not theoretical power—it is demonstrated dominion.

The Apostolic Church is not powerless.
It is a Holy Ghost-empowered army.

Chapter 6: Endued with Power from on High

Text: Acts 1:4–8

“Ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you...”

The purpose of the Holy Ghost is not just to feel good—it is to:

- Empower us to witness

CHAPTER 1 (EXPANDED)

THE SOUND OF A MIGHTY RUSHING WIND

Acts 2:1–4 —

The Birth of the Apostolic Church

1. The Divine Timing of Pentecost

“And when the day of Pentecost was fully come...”

The language of Scripture is intentional. The Spirit of God does not move randomly—He moves according to divine timing, prophetic fulfillment, and covenant alignment.

The phrase “fully come” indicates completion,

fulfillment, and divine appointment. Pentecost was not merely a Jewish feast—it was a prophetic appointment where God would pour out His Spirit upon all flesh.

This moment had been building for generations:

- It was foreshadowed in the Law
- Prophesied by the prophets
- Promised by Jesus Christ

The outpouring of the Holy Ghost in Acts 2 was not a new idea—it was the manifestation of an eternal plan.

2. Pentecost: From Harvest to Holy Ghost

In the Old Testament, Pentecost (Feast of Weeks) was associated with:

- Harvest
- Firstfruits
- Thanksgiving

But in Acts 2, the meaning is elevated:

- The harvest becomes souls
- The firstfruits become the Church
- The offering becomes yielded vessels filled with the Spirit

God transitioned Pentecost from natural harvest to spiritual harvest.

And the tool of that harvest?

The wind of the Holy Ghost.

3. The Sound from Heaven

“And suddenly there came a sound from heaven...”

Notice the origin: from heaven.

This was not man-made:

- Not emotional hype
- Not religious ritual
- Not learned behavior

It was supernatural.

The Apostolic Church does not originate from:

- Councils
- Creeds
- Denominations

It originates from heaven itself.

Everything about the true Church must carry that same signature:

- Heavenly doctrine
- Heavenly power

- Heavenly authority

If it did not come from heaven, it cannot produce heaven.

4. The Suddenly of God

“Suddenly...”

God often moves suddenly after long seasons of preparation.

- 120 prayed—but suddenly it happened
- They waited—but suddenly it came
- They obeyed—but suddenly heaven responded

This reveals a powerful principle:

God’s suddenlies are connected to man’s obedience.

The Apostolic Church today must understand:

- Revival may seem delayed
- Breakthrough may feel distant
- Promise may appear tarried

But when the moment comes—

It will happen suddenly.

5. A Mighty Rushing Wind

“...as of a rushing mighty wind...”

This is the central theme of this entire booklet:

THE WIND

Let’s break it down:

A. Wind Represents Spirit

In both Hebrew (ruach) and Greek (pneuma), the word for:

- Wind
- Breath
- Spirit

...are the same.

This means:

The wind in Acts 2 was not just natural imagery—

It was a manifestation of the Spirit of God in motion.

B. The Wind Was Mighty

This was not a gentle breeze.

It was:

- Forceful
- Overwhelming
- Uncontainable

When the Holy Ghost truly moves:

- It shakes systems
- It disrupts tradition
- It confronts religion

The modern religious world prefers a controlled atmosphere—

But the Apostolic move of God is mighty.

C. The Wind Was Rushing

It carried momentum.

It was active, not passive.

This tells us:

The Spirit of God is always moving forward.

- Forward into revival
- Forward into truth
- Forward into harvest

The Apostolic Church cannot remain stagnant and claim to be in the Spirit.

6. It Filled All the House

“...and it filled all the house...”

The wind didn't just visit—it filled.

God is not interested in partial occupation.

He desires:

- Full surrender
- Full habitation
- Full infilling

The house represents:

- The physical location
- The gathered body
- The individual vessel

When the Holy Ghost truly moves, it fills:

- The atmosphere
- The congregation
- The individual believer

7. Cloven Tongues Like As of Fire

“And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire...”

Now we move from wind to fire.

A. Fire Represents Purification

Fire burns away:

- Sin
- Carnality
- Flesh

The Holy Ghost is not just power—

It is purifying fire.

B. Fire Represents Divine Presence

Throughout Scripture:

- Moses saw God in fire
- Israel was led by fire
- The altar was consumed by fire

Now in Acts 2:

The fire rests on the believer.

This is a shift:

God is no longer dwelling in temples made with hands—

He is dwelling in people.

C. Cloven Tongues

This is critical.

The fire took the shape of tongues.

Why?

Because:

The evidence of the Spirit would be vocal.

8. The Initial Evidence: Speaking in Tongues

“And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues...”

This is not optional.

This is not symbolic.

This is not emotionalism.

This is:

THE BIBLE PATTERN

Let's establish it clearly:

- They were filled
- They spoke
- The Spirit gave utterance

This pattern is consistent throughout Acts:

- Acts 2
- Acts 10
- Acts 19

Every time the Holy Ghost was poured out—

There was speaking in tongues is the bible evidence of receiving the Holy Ghost

9. The Apostolic Doctrine vs. Modern Religion

Modern religion teaches:

- Tongues have ceased
- Tongues are optional
- Tongues are emotional

But the Bible teaches:

- Tongues are initial evidence

- Tongues are Spirit-given
- Tongues are supernatural utterance

The Apostolic Church must stand firm:

If there are no tongues, there is no biblical evidence of the Holy Ghost.

10. The Wind and the Voice

The wind produced a voice.

This connects directly to John 3:8:

“You hear the sound thereof...”

The new birth is:

- Audible
- Experiential
- Transformational

The Holy Ghost is not silent.

11. The Wind Produces Boldness

Immediately after Acts 2:

- Peter preaches boldly

- 3,000 souls are saved
- The Church explodes in growth

Why?

Because the wind produces:

- Boldness
- Authority
- Conviction

A church without boldness is a church without wind.

12. The Wind is Still Blowing Today

What happened in Acts 2 was not a one-time event.

It was the birth of a continuing experience.

The same wind is blowing today:

- In true Apostolic churches
- In Holy Ghost-filled believers with the evidence of speaking in tongues
- In revival environments

The question is not:

Is the wind blowing?

The question is:

Are you positioned to receive it?

13. Positioning Yourself for the Wind

The 120 were:

- In unity
- In obedience
- In expectation

This is the pattern:

- 1.Unity
- 2.Obedience
- 3.Expectation

When these align—

The wind will blow.

14. The Wind Cannot Be Controlled

Religion tries to control God.

But the wind:

- Cannot be programmed
- Cannot be scheduled

- Cannot be manufactured

It must be:

Received.

15. The Call of This Hour

We are not waiting for a new move—

We are returning to the original one.

The wind of Acts 2 is blowing again:

- With power
- With authority
- With truth

And it is blowing in your direction.

Chapter 1 Closing Declaration

The Apostolic Pentecostal Church was born in the wind.

It moves in the wind.

It grows in the wind.

And it will finish its mission in the wind.

Prophetic Call

Let the wind blow:

- Through your life
- Through your church
- Through your city

Do not resist it.

Do not quench it.

Do not replace it with tradition.

Final Exhortation

The sound of a mighty rushing wind is being heard again.

This is not the hour for passive religion.

This is the hour for:

- Holy Ghost power with the evidence of speaking in tongues
- Apostolic authority
- Jesus Name truth
