

Spitting Out the Gimmicks: A Call for Authentic Apostolic Pentecostal Preaching

I. Introduction

A. Opening Prayer

B. Scriptural Reference: 2 Timothy 4:2 - “Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.”

C. Theme: A call to reject superficiality and embrace authentic Apostolic Pentecostal preaching.
