Foreword

My booklet is written for those who are tired of chasing money and are ready to step into God's ordained abundance. The shift begins in the spirit, is confirmed by the Word, and is demonstrated by faithful action. If you are ready to stop the hustle and let money be attracted to you by the anointing and favor of the Lord Jesus Christ, this is your blueprint.

Introduction

Many believers are trapped in a cycle of chasing money—worrying, scrambling, compromising values, and exhausting themselves for temporary gain. The Bible teaches a different way: when you align with God's purpose and walk in His principles, provision will follow. "Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matthew 6:33). Money chases those who are anchored in God's assignment, administered by wise stewardship, and empowered by the Holy Ghost.

Chapter 1 — The Shift: From Chasing to Attracting

- Chasing money consumes the mind and soul. It can produce haste, compromise, and short-term thinking. The cost may be your peace, relationships, and

spiritual effectiveness.

- To become a money magnet you must shift your identity: you are not a money chaser; you are a vessel called to kingdom purpose. When you walk in that calling, the Spirit brings favor and open doors.
- The change begins with the Lord Jesus Christ. Your confidence is not in schemes, but in the One who gives you authority and anointing to fulfill your assignment (John 10:10; 3 John 2).

Chapter 2 — The Blueprint Is in the Word

- God's Word contains His financial laws and kingdom principles. Study Scripture and let it form your financial DNA.
- Malachi 3:7–10: Tithes, testing God's provision, and the windows of heaven being opened.
- Luke 6:38: Giving and receiving — measure pressed down, shaken together, running over.
- Matthew 6:33: Priority of the Kingdom brings provision.
- John 10:10; 3 John 2: The Lord's desire for abundant life and prosperity in soul, body, and provision.
- The Word will guide your heart and actions. Abundance is not mere accumulation; it is provision to fulfill God's mandate.

Chapter 3 — Tithes, Offerings, and Covenant Giving

- Tithing and giving are not rituals; they are spiritual keys. They establish covenant trust and open God's channels of blessing.
- Tithe: Give the first tenth as a recognition that God is the source. Malachi speaks of returning to God and seeing His response.
- Offerings: Beyond tithe, offerings are seeds of faith — gifts for the work of the Kingdom, obedience to vision, and acts of worship.
- Giving aligns your heart with God's purposes and breaks the spirit of lack. When you give, you set a spiritual law in motion that invites return and favor.

Chapter 4 — The Anointing and Divine Favor

- The anointing of the Holy Ghost positions you to be fruitful and to attract resources necessary for your assignment. God's favor opens doors men cannot.
- Money flows to those who carry value—value created by God through gifts, skills, anointing, and character.
- Your assignment, when fueled by the anointing, becomes a magnet. People and opportunities are drawn to anointed work because God honors His call.

Chapter 5 — Alignment with Your Apostolic-Pentecostal Assignment

- Know your assignment. Seek the Lord for clarity about your calling and purpose. Don't get distracted by other people's definitions of success.
- Stay in alignment: remain connected to apostolic authority, sound doctrine, and spiritual covering. Beware of ministries and influences that pull you off-course.
- Develop the gifts and skills for your assignment. Training, mentorship, and practical experience amplify the anointing.

Chapter 6 — Working Smart, Not Just Hard

- Hard work without strategy can lead to burnout. The Holy Spirit helps you work intelligently—leveraging talents, systems, partnerships, and technology.
- Build multiple streams of kingdom-aligned income: ministry services, businesses, products, speaking, writing, investments. Diversification protects and expands provision.
- Collaborate. Kingdom multiplication often happens through partnerships and networks aligned with God's purpose.

Chapter 7 — Stewardship: How to Use the Money God Sends

- When money comes, use it for God's purpose. Stewardship honors the Giver and secures continued blessing.
- Prioritize: Kingdom work, family, debt reduction, savings, investment.
- Budget: Plan where every dollar goes; be faithful in small things.
- Reinvest: Grow what God entrusts to you so it can produce more for the Kingdom.
- Avoid greed, waste, and foolish speculation.

Faithful stewards multiply what they have.

Chapter 8 — Practical Steps to Activate the Blueprint

1. Repent and Reset: Repent of chasing money and set your heart to pursue God's assignment.
2. Study the Word: Commit to a daily time of Scripture focused on God's principles for provision.
3. Establish Tithing and Giving: Begin or renew a consistent practice of tithing and sacrificial offerings.
4. Seek Alignment: Get spiritual counsel and place yourself under apostolic/pastoral covering.

5. Clarify Your Assignment: Journal, pray, and seek prophetic confirmation of your calling.
6. Develop Skills: Enroll in training, seek mentorship, and build competencies for your assignment.
7. Create a Financial Plan: Budget, save, reduce unnecessary debt, and plan for investments.
8. Build a Kingdom Business Plan: If called to business, create a plan that serves people and advances the Gospel.
9. Pray and Fast Regularly: Ask for supernatural provision, open doors, and divine strategies.
10. Declare God's Promises: Speak Scripture over your finances and assignment daily.

Chapter 9 — Spiritual Disciplines That Magnify Provision

- Worship: Keeps your heart right and attracts God's presence.
- Prayer: Daily communion and prophetic direction.
- Fasting: Opens spiritual channels for breakthroughs and clears distractions.
- Generosity: A lifestyle that positions you for overflow.

- Accountability: Have leaders and peers who can correct, encourage, and hold you to kingdom standards.

Chapter 10 — Declarations, Prayers, and Confessions

- Declaration examples to speak daily:
- “I am not a money chaser; I am a money magnet for God’s kingdom.”
- “The anointing of the Holy Ghost attracts divine provision to my assignment.”
- “I tithe and give; I open the windows of heaven and receive more than enough.”
- “My value is aligned with God’s purpose; opportunities and resources come to me.”
- Short prayer: “Lord Jesus, I thank You for my assignment. Anoint me to fulfill it. I repent of chasing money and choose to be faithful. Open the windows of heaven and pour out provision so I may advance Your Kingdom. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”

Chapter 11 — A 30-Day Starter Plan

Week 1: Repent, reorient, recommit to tithing and daily Word.

Week 2: Clarify assignment, list gifts and marketable skills, begin training.

Week 3: Create a simple budget and savings plan; start one small revenue stream.

Week 4: Launch a plan for giving and kingdom spending; pray for open doors and follow up on opportunities.

Chapter 12 — Warnings and Wisdom

- Beware of prosperity without purpose. Wealth is a tool to fulfill the mission, not an end in itself.
- Avoid greed, pride, and shortcuts. True abundance is fruit of holiness, work, and obedience.
- Test every prophetic word and opportunity against Scripture and wise counsel.

Conclusion: Walking Forward as a Money Magnet

You are called to be fruitful, create wealth, and use it for the advancement of the Kingdom. The blueprint is simple but holy: align with Jesus, obey the Word, tithe and give, develop your calling, steward wisely, and allow the anointing to attract provision. When your life is fully surrendered to the Lord, money will pursue you because God pursues His purpose through you.

Final Charge

Begin today. Make the commitment to stop chasing money and to start building kingdom value. Be faithful in the little things, and God will entrust you with much. Walk in the anointing. Receive favor. Become the money magnet God designed you to be.
