



# SPIRITUAL LAWS *of* APOSTOLIC PENTECOSTAL LEADERSHIP

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## Introduction

Over the years, the church has been inundated with secular books on leadership that have been used and taught in local Apostolic Pentecostal congregations. Many of these teachings stem from humanistic and secular perspectives that lack the anointing of the Holy Ghost and inspiration from the Word of God. As Apostolic Pentecostals, we find our leadership model in the Lord Jesus Christ. We can glean insights from our Bible, particularly from the Book of Proverbs and exemplary figures such as Moses, Joshua, Gideon, David, Daniel, the three Hebrew boys, and the twelve Apostles. Everything we need to know about leadership is found in the Word of God. We must never compromise by adopting secular systems and concepts from individuals who are not saved, who have not been baptized in the Holy Ghost and fire with the evidence of speaking in tongues, and who have not been baptized in Jesus' name. We should not have denominational preachers in the pulpit who are not born again of water and Spirit. Many leadership books are filled with Buddhist and Eastern religious concepts, meditation, New Age ideology, and pride and covetousness—worldly ideologies that do not align with our faith. Jesus is God, and He is the best leadership model to teach, live by, and follow. We must be Apostolic Pentecostal in our leadership methods and never mix secular with spiritual; it

simply does not work.

## 100 Spiritual Laws of Apostolic Pentecostal Leadership

1. Faith in God: Trusting wholeheartedly in God's sovereign plan and purpose for His church, believing in His ability to work miracles through us. Scripture: Hebrews 11:1 - "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

2. Prayer: Prioritizing fervent prayer—both personal and corporate—as the lifeblood of ministry, invoking the power of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:17 - "Pray without ceasing."

3. Bible Study: Committing to the diligent study of Scripture, allowing the Holy Ghost to reveal divine truths and guidance. Scripture: 2 Timothy 2:15 - "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

4. Holiness: Living a life set apart for God, reflecting His character in every aspect of life, as a witness of His holiness. Scripture: 1 Peter 1:16 - "Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy."

5. Servanthood: Embracing the call to lead by serving others, following the example of Jesus, who came to serve, not to be served. Scripture: Mark 10:45 - "For even the Son of man came not to be

ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.”

6.     Unity in the Spirit: Promoting harmony and oneness within the church body, reflecting the unity of the Spirit and the bond of peace. Scripture: Ephesians 4:3 - “Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”

7.     Accountability: Being accountable to the Lord Jesus Christ, your pastor, and fellow leaders, fostering a culture of transparency and trust, recognizing that we are all under the authority of Christ. Scripture: Proverbs 27:17 - “Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.”

8.     Discipleship: Actively investing in the spiritual growth and maturity of others, mentoring them to be Holy Ghost leaders—water baptized in Jesus’ name and equipped for the work of the ministry. Scripture: Matthew 28:19-20 - “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations...”

9.     Integrity: Upholding honesty and transparency in all dealings, reflecting the character of Christ and the truth of His Word. Scripture: Proverbs 10:9 - “He that walketh uprightly walketh surely: but he that perverteth his ways shall be known.”

10.    Vision from the Holy Ghost: Seeking and articulating God’s vision for the church, inspired by the Holy Ghost, and encouraging others to join in His

mission.Scripture: Proverbs 29:18 - “Where there is no vision, the people perish...”

11. Agape Love: Demonstrating unconditional love to all, as Christ commanded, fostering a culture of acceptance and grace through the Spirit.Scripture: John 13:34 - “A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you...”

12. Forgiveness: Practicing forgiveness as a fundamental aspect of Christian community, reflecting Christ’s love and mercy.Scripture: Ephesians 4:32 - “And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ’s sake hath forgiven you.”

13. Humility in Leadership: Leading with a humble heart, acknowledging that true greatness comes from serving others and being led by the Spirit.Scripture: Philippians 2:3 - “Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.”

14. Stewardship of God’s Gifts: Managing resources wisely and faithfully, recognizing that all we have belongs to God and is to be used for His glory.Scripture: 1 Peter 4:10 - “As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.”

15. Evangelism with Power: Actively sharing the gospel message and the transformative power of Jesus Christ, empowered by the Holy Ghost.

Scripture: Mark 16:15 - “And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.” and Acts 1:4-8.

16. Worship in Spirit and Truth: Fostering an environment of genuine worship, where the presence of God is welcomed and honored through heartfelt praise. Scripture: John 4:24 - “God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.”

17. Teaching with Apostolic Pentecostal Authority: Equipping others with sound doctrine, emphasizing the importance of biblical literacy and the revelation of the Holy Ghost, and teaching with the authority given by God. Scripture: 2 Timothy 4:2 - “Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.”

18. Encouragement by the Spirit: Building up and uplifting others in faith, fostering a spirit of hope, positivity, and empowerment through the Holy Ghost. Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:11 - “Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.”

19. Faithfulness in Service: Being reliable and steadfast in service, demonstrating commitment to God’s work and the mission of the church. Scripture: 1 Corinthians 4:2 - “Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.”

20. Patience through the Spirit: Exercising



patience in all situations, trusting in God's timing and plan, and relying on the Holy Ghost for strength. Scripture: Galatians 5:22 - "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith."

21. Conflict Resolution with Love: Addressing conflicts biblically and lovingly, seeking peace and reconciliation through the guidance of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Matthew 5:9 - "Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God."

22. Generosity as a Reflection of God: Giving freely of time, talent, and treasure, reflecting God's generosity toward us and the abundance of His grace. Scripture: 2 Corinthians 9:7 - "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver."

23. Empowerment of the Spirit: Empowering others to fulfill their God-given potential and calling through the baptism of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues. Scripture: Acts 2:4 - "And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance." Additional Scriptures: Acts 2:17-18, Acts 2:33, Acts 2:38-39, Mark 16:17, Acts 10:44-48, Acts 19:1-6, Acts 1:4-8.

24. Courage in Christ: Standing firm in faith amidst challenges, trusting in God's strength



and provision through the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Joshua 1:9 - “Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.”

25. Vision Casting by the Spirit: Clearly communicating the church’s mission and vision, inspired by the Holy Ghost, and inspiring collective action. Scripture: Habakkuk 2:2 - “And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.”

26. Mentoring Future Leaders: Guiding and nurturing future Apostolic Pentecostal leaders, investing in the next generation of believers through prayer and discipleship. Scripture: 2 Timothy 2:2 - “And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.”

27. Cultural Revival with Apostolic Pentecostal Truth: Engaging with the community context while remaining faithful to biblical truths and the message of the Gospel. Scripture: 1 Corinthians 9:22 - “To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some.”

28. Prayer and Fasting for Spiritual Breakthrough: Seeking God through fasting and prayer, deepening spiritual intimacy and reliance on the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Matthew 17:21 - “Howbeit

this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.”

29. Recognizing the Nine Spiritual Gifts:

Acknowledging and utilizing spiritual gifts within the body of Christ for effective ministry, as empowered by the Holy Ghost. Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:7 - “But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.”

30. Respect for Godly Leaders: Honoring and respecting Apostolic Pentecostal ministers and saints who live the life of a Christian while standing firm against sin and refusing to compromise the truth. Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13 - “And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labor among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you; and to esteem them very highly in love for their work’s sake.”

31. Discipline through the Spirit: Maintaining self-control and discipline in all aspects of life and ministry, yielding to the Holy Ghost’s guidance. Scripture: Galatians 5:23 - “Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.”

32. Joy in the Holy Ghost: Cultivating a spirit of joy in service, reflecting the joy of the Lord as our strength and the fruit of the Spirit. Scripture: Nehemiah 8:10 - “The joy of the Lord is your strength.”

33. Compassionate Leadership: Showing empathy and care for others, particularly those who are hurting or marginalized, as Christ demonstrated.

Scripture: Colossians 3:12 - “Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering.”

34. Truthfulness in All Things: Committing to truth in all communications, embodying the truth of the Gospel and the integrity of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Ephesians 4:15 - “But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ.”

35. Obedience to God’s Word: Faithfully following God’s commands and leading others to do the same, empowered by the Holy Ghost. Scripture: John 14:15 - “If ye love me, keep my commandments.”

36. Embracing Diversity in Christ: Celebrating the diversity of the body of Christ, recognizing that every member is vital to the Kingdom. Scripture: Galatians 3:28 - “There is neither Jew nor Greek, neither bond nor free, neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.”

37. Reconciliation through Christ: Seeking to restore broken relationships, reflecting the heart of God for unity in the Spirit. Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:18 - “And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation.”

38. Prayer Support for One Another: Providing prayer support for others, fostering a culture of intercession and collective faith. Scripture:

James 5:16 - “Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed...”

39. Faith-Based Decision Making: Making decisions rooted in faith, seeking God’s wisdom and direction through prayer and the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Proverbs 3:5-6 - “Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.”

40. Engaging in Spiritual Warfare: Actively engaging in spiritual battles through prayer, recognizing the reality of spiritual opposition and the authority of Christ. Scripture: Ephesians 6:12 - “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.”

41. Family Focus in Ministry: Prioritizing family in ministry, understanding that strong families are the foundation of the church and the Kingdom of God. Scripture: Ephesians 6:4 - “And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.”

42. Community Engagement with Love: Actively serving the local community, demonstrating Christ’s love in action and the power of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Matthew 25:40 - “And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of

these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.”

43. Celebrating God’s Faithfulness:

Celebrating milestones and achievements, recognizing God’s faithfulness and the work of the Holy Ghost in our lives. Scripture: Psalm 100:4 - “Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.”

44. Listening to the Holy Ghost: Being

attentive to the Holy Spirit and the needs of others, fostering a culture of open communication and receptivity. Scripture: John 10:27 - “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.”

45. Gratitude for God’s Blessings: Cultivating

a thankful heart, recognizing God’s blessings in every circumstance and acknowledging His provision. Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:18 - “In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.”

46. Setting Boundaries in Leadership:

Establishing healthy boundaries in leadership to ensure personal and spiritual well-being, guided by the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Proverbs 25:28 - “He that hath no rule over his own spirit is like a city that is broken down, and without walls.”

47. Adaptability to the Spirit’s Leading:

Being flexible to change when necessary, remaining sensitive to the leading of the Holy Ghost in all decisions. Scripture: Isaiah 30:21 - “And thine ears

shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it...”

48. Visionary Leadership through the Holy Ghost: Inspiring others with a compelling vision, encouraging innovative thinking and divine insight. Scripture: Proverbs 16:3 - “Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established.”

49. Conflict Prevention through Unity: Taking proactive steps to prevent conflicts, promoting peace and understanding within the church. Scripture: Romans 12:18 - “If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.”

50. Upholding Scriptural Authority: Maintaining the authority of Scripture in teaching and practice, grounding all actions in God’s Word and the Holy Ghost. Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:16 - “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.”

51. Fellowship in the Spirit: Building strong relationships within the church, fostering genuine Apostolic Pentecostal community and connection through the love of the Lord Jesus Christ. Scripture: Acts 2:42 - “And they continued steadfastly in the apostles’ doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.”

52. Apostolic Pentecostal Covenantal Relationship: Committing to long-term relationships based on trust, mutual support, and the love of God

through the New Birth of Water and Spirit according to Acts 2:38. Scripture: Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 - “Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow...”

53. Holistic Ministry through the Spirit: Addressing spiritual, emotional, and physical needs, reflecting Christ’s compassion and the wholeness found in Him. Scripture: Matthew 9:36 - “But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.”

54. Crisis Management with Faith: Leading effectively during crises, providing stability and hope in challenging times through reliance on the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Philippians 4:6-7 - “Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.”

55. Celebrating Different Ethnicities in the Body: Valuing and embracing different backgrounds and experiences within the church, reflecting the richness of God’s creation. Scripture: Revelation 7:9 - “After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues...”

56. Innovation through the Holy Ghost: Embracing new ideas for ministry, remaining open to the leading of the Holy Ghost for fresh insights.



Scripture: Isaiah 43:19 - "Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it?"

57. Endurance through Trials: Persevering through trials and challenges, trusting in God's faithfulness and the strength of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: James 1:12 - "Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him."

58. Mentorship in the Spirit: Actively mentoring others in their faith journey, investing in the future of the church with the guidance of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Titus 2:3-4 - "The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands..."

59. Apostolic Pentecostal Faith-Based Leadership: Leading with a biblical foundation, ensuring all actions align with Scripture and the leading of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Joshua 1:8 - "This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night..."

60. Establishing Prayer Partners: Creating partnerships for prayer support, recognizing the power of collective prayer and intercession. Scripture: Matthew 18:19-20 - "Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that

they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.”

61. Building an Apostolic Pentecostal Faith Community: Cultivating a strong sense of community, where believers support and encourage one another in the faith. Scripture: Hebrews 10:24-25 - “And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together...”

62. Restoration through Grace: Helping restore those who have fallen, embodying the grace and mercy of Christ and the power of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Galatians 6:1 - “Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness...”

63. Public Witness of Faith: Living out faith in public spaces, being a light in the world and a testament to the power of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Matthew 5:16 - “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”

64. Celebrating Differences in Unity: Embracing different perspectives within the church, fostering an inclusive environment rooted in love. Scripture: Romans 15:5-7 - “Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be like-minded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind and one mouth glorify God...”

65. Sabbath Rest in the Spirit: Recognizing

the importance of rest and renewal, honoring God's design for balance and spiritual rejuvenation. Scripture: Exodus 20:8 - "Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy."

66. Teamwork in the Body of Christ:  
Collaborating with others in ministry, recognizing the strength of working together under the leadership of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:12 - "For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ."

67. Cultural Sensitivity through Love:  
Understanding and respecting cultural differences, engaging with diverse communities in love and truth. Scripture: 1 Corinthians 9:22 - "To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some."

68. Vision Alignment with God's Will:  
Ensuring alignment with the pastor's vision for the church, fostering unity in purpose under the guidance of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Proverbs 16:3 - "Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established."

69. Commitment to Spiritual Growth:  
Pursuing personal spiritual development, continuously seeking to grow in faith and knowledge of God. Scripture: 2 Peter 3:18 - "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus

Christ.”

70. Constructive Conflict Resolution:

Addressing disagreements with love and grace, seeking God’s wisdom in resolution through prayer. Scripture: Proverbs 15:1 - “A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.”

71. Mission Focus on Outreach: Keeping the

mission of the church at the forefront, prioritizing outreach and evangelism as commanded by Christ. Scripture: Matthew 28:19-20 - “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost...”Note: Jesus is the Name of the Father, Jesus is the Name of the Son, Jesus is the Name of the Holy Ghost. The only valid baptism is to be baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. If you have been baptized in the titles Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, you need to be rebaptized in Jesus’ name only.

72. Prayerful Decision Making: Seeking God’s

guidance in decisions, trusting in His direction and the leading of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: James 1:5 - “If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.”

73. Continuous Learning in the Apostolic

Pentecostal Faith: Pursuing ongoing education and growth, remaining teachable in faith and open to the Holy Ghost’s leading. Scripture: Proverbs 1:5 - “A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man

of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels.”

74. Engaging All Generations in Ministry: Actively involving all age groups in ministry, recognizing the value of every generation in God’s Kingdom. Scripture: Joel 2:28 - “And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy...”

75. Community Outreach as an Apostolic Pentecostal Witness: Actively reaching out to the community, demonstrating God’s love in action through service and evangelism. Scripture: Acts 10:38 - “How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil...”

76. Crisis Response with Compassion: Preparing for and responding to crises with grace, compassion, and the wisdom of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: 2 Corinthians 1:4 - “Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble...”

77. Consistent Faithful Witness: Being a consistent witness for Christ, living out the Gospel daily through the power of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Acts 1:8 - “But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me...”

78. Caring Leadership with Compassion: Leading with care and compassion, reflecting the

heart of God for His people and the community.

Scripture: 1 Peter 5:2-3 - “Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind...”

79. Spiritual Discernment through Prayer: Seeking wisdom in decision-making, relying on the Holy Spirit for guidance and insight. Scripture: Philippians 1:9-10 - “And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; That ye may approve things that are excellent...”

80. Character Development in the Lord Jesus Christ: Focusing on character over charisma, valuing integrity, Apostolic authenticity, and the fruit of the Spirit. Scripture: Galatians 5:22-23 - “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance...”

81. Empathy through the Holy Ghost: Understanding and sharing the feelings of others, fostering a compassionate Apostolic Pentecostal Church community led by the Spirit while building strong and stable believers. Scripture: Romans 12:15 - “Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.”

82. Holistic Health in the Lord Jesus Christ: Promoting physical, emotional, and spiritual health, recognizing the importance of overall well-being in

Christ.Scripture: 3 John 1:2 - “Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.”

83. Apostolic Pentecostal Visionary Thinking through Faith: Encouraging innovative and visionary ideas, remaining open to new possibilities inspired by the Holy Ghost.Scripture: Isaiah 43:19 - “Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it?”

84. Conflict Mediation with Grace: Acting as mediators in conflicts, promoting reconciliation and understanding through prayer and love.Scripture: Matthew 5:24 - “Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother...”

85. Spiritual Accountability in the Body: Holding one another accountable in faith, fostering mutual growth and support in the Spirit under the leadership of the pastor/elder of the local Apostolic Pentecostal Church.Scripture: Galatians 6:1 - “Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness...”

86. Faithful Stewardship of Resources: Being responsible stewards of resources, honoring God in all that we manage for His glory.Scripture: Matthew 25:21 - “His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant...”

87. Apostolic Pentecostal Church Community Building in the Lord Jesus Christ: Actively fostering



community among members, creating a sense of belonging and unity in the Spirit. Scripture: Ephesians 2:19 - “Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God.”

88. Celebrating Milestones with Gratitude: Recognizing significant achievements and celebrating God’s faithfulness with joy and thanksgiving. Scripture: Psalm 126:3 - “The Lord hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad.”

89. Prioritizing Prayer and Worship: Creating a vibrant spiritual atmosphere through prioritizing prayer and worship, inviting the Holy Ghost’s presence. Scripture: Psalm 95:6 - “O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the Lord our maker.”

90. Supportive Environment in the Apostolic Pentecostal Church: Creating a supportive atmosphere where individuals feel valued, encouraged, and empowered by the Holy Ghost. Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:11 - “Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.”

91. Faithful Leadership as Sons and Daughters Servants: Being reliable and trustworthy leaders, embodying the qualities of the Lord Jesus Christ and the servant heart of a leader. Scripture: Mark 10:43-44 - “But so shall it not be among you: but whosoever will be great among you, shall be your

minister: And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all.”

92.    **Courageous Leadership through Faith:**  
Taking bold steps in faith, trusting in God’s guidance and provision through the Holy Ghost.Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:7 - “For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.”

93.    **Inclusivity in the Lord Jesus Christ’s Love:**  
Welcoming all sinners reaching for their souls to be born again of water and Spirit into the kingdom of God, reflecting God’s love for everyone while never condoning or compromising the Scriptures.Scripture: Romans 15:7 - “Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God.”

94.    **Biblical Counseling through the Spirit:**  
Providing counsel rooted in Scripture, offering guidance that aligns with God’s Word and the Holy Ghost’s leading.Scripture: Proverbs 19:20 - “Hear counsel, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.”

95.    **Crisis Preparation with Wisdom:**  
Preparing for potential crises, equipping the church to respond effectively with faith and prayer.Scripture: Proverbs 22:3 - “A prudent man foreseeth the evil, and hideth himself: but the simple pass on, and are punished.”

96.    **Spiritual Resilience through the Holy Ghost:** Building resilience in faith, encouraging perseverance through trials with the strength of the

Holy Ghost. Scripture: Philippians 4:13 - “I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.”

97. Missionary Focus on Global Outreach: Supporting global missions, recognizing the call to spread the Gospel to all nations as Christ commanded. Scripture: Matthew 28:19 - “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.” The Name of the Father is Jesus - The Name of the Son is Jesus - The Name of the Holy Ghost is Jesus

The only valid Baptism is in Jesus Name .The Fulfillment of Matt 28.19 is Acts 2.38

98. Apostolic Pentecostal Blood Covenant in Relationships: Demonstrating love that reflects God’s covenant, embodying faithfulness and commitment in all relationships in holiness, particularly between a man and a woman in marriage. Anything outside of this covenant is considered an abomination to the Lord Jesus Christ. Scripture: Genesis 2:24 - “Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.” We stand against homosexuality, lesbianism, bisexuality, fornication, and adultery; it’s an abomination to the Lord Jesus Christ. We firmly take a stance against transgenderism. God created male and female; that’s not to be messed with!

99. Faithful Communication in Truth: Communicating clearly and effectively, ensuring

messages align with Apostolic doctrine and the leading of the Holy Ghost. Scripture: Ephesians 4:29 - “Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.”

100. Eternal Perspective in All Endeavors: Keeping an eternal Apostolic Pentecostal perspective in all endeavors, focusing on what truly matters in God’s Kingdom and the call to be born again of water and Spirit according to Acts 2:38. Scripture: Colossians 3:2 - “Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.”

These principles serve as enduring guidelines for Apostolic Pentecostal leaders, equipping them to lead with integrity, faith, and holiness, both within and without, and in separation from the world as they fulfill their God-given calling, empowered by the Holy Ghost and the evidence of speaking in tongues. We are committed to raising up Apostolic Pentecostal leaders and believers who will boldly proclaim the salvation plan of Acts 2:38 and fulfill the Great Commission in our communities and beyond, while respecting those who live the Christian life and standing firm against sin without compromising the truth.
