Introduction

The key to the door is the revelation and obedience of Acts 2:38–39. The purpose of a key is to open a lock and give access. The same is true spiritually: there is a key that opens the door to the kingdom of God. My booklet lists and clarifies the message of Acts 2:38 as the plan of redemption and the one true way into the Kingdom.

14. The Key Metaphor

- The angel had a key to open the door.
- Keys open locks and give access.

- There are many kinds of keys in life: keys to a house, keys to mathematics, keys to knowledge, keys to wisdom.
- But there is one key that opens the way of salvation: The revelation of who The Lord Jesus Christ is God the Father incarnate manifested in the flesh is essential to Salvation and obedience to the plan of Salvation he gave He gave us is Acts 2.38 .

Acts 2:38–39: The Gateway to Salvation

- Acts 2:38–39 is the gateway to salvation into the kingdom of God.
- To enter the kingdom we must obey and experience Acts 2:38–39: repentance, water baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and the baptism in the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues.
- Preachers and messengers are transmitters of the voice of God when they preach this message of the hour is Acts 2.38 Jesus is God message .

The Revelation of Jesus Christ: One God

- The key to the way of salvation is the revelation of who Jesus Christ is: God manifested in the flesh.
- Jesus is the Father, Jesus is the Son, Jesus is the Holy Ghost — one God manifested in singular in the old testament and New testament, and His name is

The Lord Jesus Christ .

- Jesus is the key to the revelation of salvation. He gave us the plan of redemption. There is only one door, one key, one shepherd, one way, one truth, one spirit undivided, and undivided—is a spirit undivided—the—and now the Lord Jesus Christ is that spirit 2 Cor 3.17-18 .

One Door, One Key, One Shepherd, One Bride

- There is only one doorway to eternal life: Jesus said, “I am the door” to the sheepfold.
- There is one shepherd and one sheepfold — the Apostolic Pentecostal Bride birthed on the day of Pentecost.
- The true church is not a denomination, organization, or religion. It is the living organism — the Bride, the Body, the Tabernacle, the Temple of the Holy Ghost — the corporate Bride of Christ.

The Apostolic Pentecostal Message

- The Apostolic Pentecostal message is the Bride message. Acts 2:38 is the message of redemption.
- The New Testament Apostolic Pentecostal Church was birthed in the Upper Room (Acts 2:1–38–39).
- This church is not a denomination or organization; it is the living Bride and the habitation of the Holy Ghost.

The Steps to Receive the Key (How to Be Saved)

- Repent and believe on the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Be baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ for the remission of sins.
- Receive the baptism in the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues.
- Faith is the key that will unlock the door as you obey and experience Acts 2:38–39.

The Evidence of the Holy Ghost

- The sign of the Bride — and the seal of the Holy Ghost of promise — is speaking in tongues (see Ephesians 1:13–14).
- The baptism in the Holy Ghost and fire comes with the evidence of speaking in tongues.

The Scripture as the Key (Key of David — Isaiah 22)

- The Scriptures unlock the door; the Word was God and the name of the Word is the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Isaiah 22:22: “And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.” The key belongs to God and opens the house of David — the authority and revelation of God’s plan.

Personal Testimony

- I found the key when I was 13 years old when I received the revelation of the oneness of God, was baptized in Jesus' name, and received the baptism in the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues. That experience revealed the plan of redemption and opened the door.

A Call to Obedience and Separation

- Many denominations, organizations, and trinitarian churches lost the key when they adopted doctrinal statements, dogmas, bylaws, and manmade systems.
- The Protestant, Catholic, and denominational systems, with their traditions and organizational secrecy, are pictured as the mother that the harlot sits upon in Revelation 17–18. Believers are called out of her (Revelation 18:4) into the Acts 2:38 experience of new birth — born of water and the Spirit.
- It is not the name of your denomination that saves you. The Apostolic Pentecostal Church holds the key to unlock the mystery of the kingdom of God — the new birth in water and in Spirit.
