We Need to Preach Deliverance in Our Apostolic
Pentecostal Churches as Never Before:
Teaching People How to Experience Deliverance in
Jesus' Name — It Is the Will of the Lord Jesus Christ
to Set Captives Free

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Introduction & Core Theme

Jesus is God in the flesh. He came to destroy the works of the devil and to set captives free I John 3.8 I John 4.4 -Rev 12.11 (John 1; Luke 4; Isaiah 61; John 8:36). Deliverance is a fruit of the gospel: repentance, baptism in Jesus' name, and the infilling of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues the power of the Holy Ghost will produce freedom from sin, demonic oppression, and destructive habits. It is the will of the Lord Jesus Christ that His people walk in freedom.

The Great Commission to Set Captives Free Luke 4:18; Luke 24:47-49

Deliverance starts with the conviction of the Holy Ghost, you got to want to be delivered from the bondage and sin that holds you as a captive slave to the enemy. You can be delivered (Acts 2:21)! There is deliverance in Jesus name, freedom from every sin and bondage to repentance and confession of the

sin and the iniquity that has you bound. Confess it bring it into the light of the Lord Jesus, Jesus Christ, and his illuminating grace and mercy starts with repentance, godly sorrow for the sin coming under the conviction of the Holy Ghost after repentance, water baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ for the remission of sins.

Acts 2:38 is when you're born again of the water and of the spirit John 3:3-8 through the new birth all things pass away all things become new. The serpent seed of sin has crushed by the incarnation of Jehovah, the everlasting father in the flesh. The Lord Jesus Christ, in the form of a man became our substitutionary sacrifice Calvary God died in the form of a man in the flesh the flesh of God suffered as the second man, the Lord from heaven, the invisible God become visible Tabernacle himself among us.

He became your curse. Your substitutionary sacrifice paid the price for your sin and mine the power of the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ is perfect blood precious blood sinless blood is the blood of God the father, eternal undivided spirit is the Lord Jesus Christ. He died to set us free from slavery. You can be free you can be delivered not through a psychologist, not through psychiatry not to pills go through programs of men to counseling through the power of the Lord Jesus Christ, resurrection power

you can be free today delivered and never go back to the bondage I had you bound today is the day of your deliverance.

The Bible is a book of deliverance God's plan to set captive free to today's your day of salvation Bible salvation Acts 2:38. You must come to the revelation of the authority of the believer the apostolic Pentecostal believer has been given power and authority over the devil you must discover it. You must know it. You must use the power that God has given you the devil is a bluffer. He does not have power and authority over you.

Matt 18:18-20 at the cross of the Lord Jesus Christ, every accusation every sin in bondage that you ever committed has been nailed to the cross of Calvary. Jesus paid the price to cancel the devils, accusations and assaults against you and set you free from bondage through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. It's impossible to please God without faith (Hebrews 11:6). Speak the seed word of faith against the serpent seed of Satan that sends powers broken over you every curse of witchcraft, every generational curse in your family and your DNA to association in a simulation is destroyed by the power of the blood of Calvary crossed the Lord Jesus Christ, has nailed your sin to the cross, and he has canceled the curse over your life you can walk in freedom and

deliverance from every habit when you come to the revelation of the authority of the apostolic Pentecostal believer has been given power and authority over Satan to cast out Satan and demons and take authority over sin, sickness, disease, death, and debt in Jesus name. (Matt 18:18-20)

- Jesus demonstrated authority over demons (Matt. 8; Mark 1; Luke 4; Mark 5).
- The church is given authority in Jesus' name (Matt. 10:1; Luke 10:19; John 1:12).
- Baptism in Jesus' name and the baptism in the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues empower us (Acts 1:4–8; Acts 2:21–38).

The Seven Ways — Prayer and Fasting for Deliverance (Mark 9:23–29)

- Mark 9:23–29 shows that faith, prayer—and where required, fasting—are crucial. Below are seven practical, scriptural ways to engage prayer and fasting so “these kinds” come out:

Repentant Prayer (Personal and Apostolic Pentecostal Corporate prayer and Fasting)

- Begin with genuine repentance (Acts 2:38; 1 John 1:9). Confess sin, return to God, and ask for

cleansing. Deliverance begins with a heart turned to God.

Simple, Persistent Prayer

- Pray specifically and persistently for release (Luke 18:1–8; Mark 9:29). Pray until there is a spiritual response; do not accept a superficial result.

Fasting with Prayer

- Fast to intensify prayer and break strongholds (Matt. 17:21 [KJV], Isa. 58, Joel 2). Fasting weakens the flesh and demonstrates dependence on God—Mark 9 indicates fasting may be necessary for certain strongholds.

Faith-Filled Action

- Exercise faith: “If thou canst believe, all things are possible” (Mark 9:23). Belief is expressed by calling on Jesus’ name, commanding spirits, and obeying God’s steps (Acts 3–4, Mark 16:17).

Renunciation, Confession and Breaking Ungodly Ties

- Confess sin, renounce occult involvement, vows, or sinful agreements. Break generational patterns and

ungodly covenants in prayer (Deut. 29; Gal. 3:13).

Exercise of Apostolic Authority in Jesus' Name

- Bind and cast out spirits by the authority given to believers (Matt. 18:18; Luke 10:19). Use clear commands in Jesus' name and declare the authority of the cross.

Baptism and the Baptism with the Holy Ghost; Follow-up Discipleship

- Ensure gospel steps: repentance, water baptism in Jesus' name, and the infilling of the Holy Ghost with speaking in tongues (Acts 2; Acts 8:12–17). Follow deliverance with discipleship, accountability and the Word (John 8:31–32).

Practical Steps for Deliverance Ministry (Pulpit & Follow-up)

- Gospel first: Repentance, baptism in Jesus' name, and Holy Ghost infilling.
- Assessment: Screen for medical or mental-health issues; get consent.
- Confession & Renunciation: Have the person confess and renounce sin and any known occult ties.
- Prayer & Fasting: Begin with prayer; if needed, recommend a period of directed fasting and

intensified prayer.

- Bind & Cast: Command spirits to leave in Jesus' name with a calm, authoritative tone.
- Fill with the Holy Ghost: Pray for the infilling and for gifts/strength to maintain freedom.
- Practical aftercare: counseling, accountability groups, rehab referrals when needed, employment assistance, and long-term discipleship.
- Team approach: trained elders, deliverance workers, counselor/medical liaison.

Expanded List of Addictions and Strong Pulpit Statements

You can be delivered from:

- Heroin, morphine, fentanyl, OxyContin and other opioids
- Methamphetamine, cocaine, amphetamines
- Marijuana, vaping, tobacco
- Prescription sedatives and benzodiazepines (Xanax, etc.), pills that intoxicate
- Alcohol, pornography, sexual lusts, gambling, and related compulsions

Pulpit phrasing (direct): “In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I declare you can be free from heroin, morphine, fentanyl, methamphetamine, marijuana, pills, vaping, tobacco, alcohol, pornography and every bondage. Jesus came to set the captives free — be

delivered now!”

Sample Renunciation, Commanding and Declaration Prayers

Renunciation/Confession:

- “Heavenly Father, I confess my sins and repent. I renounce every tie to heroin, morphine, fentanyl, OxyContin, methamphetamine, marijuana, illicit drugs, pills (Xanax and others), vaping, tobacco, alcohol, pornography, gambling, and every ungodly vow. I turn from it now.”

Commanding/prayer for deliverance:

- “In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, by the authority of His blood, I command every spirit of [addiction/fear/sexual uncleanness/gambling] to come out now and go where Christ sends you. You have no right here. Leave and do not return.”

Declaration of freedom:

- “By the authority of Jesus, you are free. Receive the Holy Ghost, walk in newness of life, and be established in the church.”

Alcohol — Doctrinal & Pulpit Wording

- Doctrinal stance: Apostolic Pentecostal teaching historically urges abstinence from alcohol. Scripture references: Proverbs 20:1; Ephesians 5:18; 1 Corinthians 6:9–11.
- Pulpit wording: “We call believers to sobriety and holiness. Scripture warns that wine can be a snare. If you are struggling with alcohol, repent and seek deliverance. We will stand with you.”
- Pastoral note: Teach holiness firmly but restore kindly; avoid public shaming. Use scriptural warnings about the consequences of habitual unrepentant sin (e.g., 1 Cor. 6:9–10) while offering grace, repentance and restoration.

Medical & Safety Cautions (non-negotiable)

- Withdrawal from opioids, alcohol, or benzodiazepines can be medically dangerous or fatal. Always refer people with physical dependence to medical professionals and supervised detox before or alongside deliverance ministry.
- Severe addiction often requires professional addiction treatment, psychiatric evaluation, or inpatient rehab in addition to spiritual ministry.
- Deliverance prayer is not a substitute for medical detox, medications, or mental-health care. Coordinate ministry with medical and counseling professionals.

Counseling, Discipleship & Follow-Up

- Provide immediate and ongoing accountability: small groups, mentorship, counseling, rehab referrals, job help, and stable church community.
- Document pastoral care, maintain confidentiality, obtain consent.
- Train elders in boundaries, when to refer to professionals, and long-term discipleship strategies.

Teach people to pray, to fast, and to exercise their God-given Authority in Jesus’ Name. Provide wise pastoral care and practical follow-up so deliverance becomes a lifelong walk in holiness.
