Jesus said, "The hour cometh and now is when the true worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and in Truth." Acceptable worship is two-fold: spirit and Truth. "Spirit" -meaning: enthusiastic, heart-felt, exuberant praise. And "Truth" meaning: doctrinally correct.

Apostolic Pentecostal worship is founded on the commands God gave to His people in the Scriptures. There are numerous verses regarding the behavior God expects and requires from us when we come together to praise Him. Pentecostal praise and worship is a natural response to the presence of God and it is also an act of obedience to His Word.

Let's examine what the Bible says about true worship.

The Bible says: "They lifted up their voice to God with one accord." Acts 4:24

In response: We Pray and praise together aloud.



The Bible says: "Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless the Lord." Psalm 134:2

In response: We Lift our Hands in Praise.



The Bible says:

"Make a joyful

noise unto the Lord,make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise." Psalm 134:2

In response: We sing with all our hearts.



The Bible says: "And all the house of Israel played before the Lord on all manner of instruments." 2 Samuel 6:5

In response: We play musical instruments.



The Bible says: "O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph." Psalm 47:1

In response: We clap and shout unto

God.
