It's paganism with a CHRISTIAN miniskirt on. We must know who Jesus is. The ones that are of God know that Jesus Christ is God manifested in the flesh. He is not the second divine person of a triune Godhead or an eternal son. This is false doctrine. Isaiah 9:6 tells us the child. The son that would be born is the mighty God, the everlasting father of the prince of peace in the flesh!

9.1 Understanding Prophetic Symbolism

Revelation uses symbols to describe:

- Systems
- Powers
- Spiritual realities

9.2 Revelation 17 — The Woman

Describes:

- Influence over nations
- Religious authority
- Mixture and corruption

9.3 Revelation 18 — The Fall

Babylon represents:

- Confusion
- Systemic deception
- Spiritual mixture

Its fall represents:

- Exposure
- Judgment
- Collapse of false systems

9.4 The Call to Separation

Revelation 18:4

“Come out of her, my people...”

This is not physical—it is:

- Spiritual separation

9.5 Illustration: The Burning City
