## Introduction

The ministry of casting out demons is a vital aspect of the Apostolic Pentecostal faith. Jesus demonstrated His authority over demonic forces, and as His followers, we are called to continue this ministry. This booklet explores the biblical foundation for deliverance, the importance of commanding demons to leave, the types of demons mentioned in Scripture, and testimonies of deliverance within the church.

### *Chapter 1*

#### The Authority of Jesus’ Name

- Mark 16:17: “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name, they will cast out demons; they

will speak with new tongues.”

- This scripture emphasizes that believers have the authority to cast out demons in the name of Jesus.

## Important Principles

- Don't Talk to the Demons: Engaging in conversation with demons can lead to confusion and distraction. Instead, focus on the authority of Jesus' name.
- Don't Ask for Their Names: Jesus did not ask demons for their names; rather, He commanded them to leave. We should follow His example and exercise authority without unnecessary dialogue.

## *Chapter 2*

### The Key to Deliverance

- Mark 9:23-29: “Jesus said to him, ‘If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.’ Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, ‘Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!’ When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, ‘Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and enter him no more!’ Then the spirit cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him. And he became as one dead, so that many said, ‘He is dead.’ But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and

he arose.”

- Key Principle: Prayer and fasting are essential for effective deliverance ministry.

### *Chapter 3*

#### The Need for Deliverance in the Apostolic Pentecostal Church

- The Apostolic Pentecostal Church must recognize the importance of deliverance ministry. Many people are bound by spiritual oppression and need the freedom that comes through the power of Jesus’ name.
- Matthew 10:7: “And as you go, preach, saying, ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’ Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.”
- This command from Jesus highlights the expectation that His followers will engage in deliverance ministry.

### *Chapter 4*

#### Different Kinds of Demons in the Bible

1. Unclean Spirits: Often associated with moral impurity (Mark 1:23).
2. Legion: A large number of demons (Mark 5:9).
3. Mute Demons: Demons that cause silence or muteness (Matthew 9:32).

4. Deaf and Dumb Spirits: Spirits that cause both deafness and muteness (Mark 9:25).
5. Tormenting Spirits: Spirits that inflict pain or distress (Matthew 17:15).
6. Familiar Spirits: Spirits associated with necromancy or consulting the dead (Leviticus 19:31).
7. Evil Spirits: General term for malevolent spirits (Luke 7:21).

## *Chapter 5*

### Steps for Deliverance Ministry (Luke 4:18, Acts 10:38, Acts 2:21)

1. Pray for Guidance: Seek the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues for guidance direction before engaging in deliverance.
2. Speak with Authority: Use the name of Jesus to command the demons to leave.
3. Rebuke the Spirit: Firmly In Jesus Name rebuke the demon and command it to depart.
4. Pray for the Individual: After casting out the demon, pray for healing and restoration for the individual, focusing on their spiritual needs.

## *Chapter 6*

### The Keys of the Kingdom

- Luke 24:47-49: “And that repentance and remission



of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. And behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high.”

- Acts 1:4-8: “And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, ‘which,’ He said, ‘you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.’

Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, ‘Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?’ And He said to them, ‘It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.’”

- Acts 10:38: “How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.”

- Luke 10:19: “Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

## Chapter 7: The Power of the Holy Ghost



- Matthew 18:18-20: “Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”
- Greek Word Meaning:
- Bind (δέω, deō): To tie or fasten; to restrict.
- Loose (λύω, luō): To unbind; to release.
- John 1:12-13: “But as many as received Him, to them He gave the Power to become children of God, to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.”

## *Chapter 8*

### The New Birth and Authority

- We have been given the keys of the kingdom through the baptism in the Holy Ghost and fire, evidenced by speaking in tongues.
- Matthew 16:18-19: “And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock, I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be

loosed in heaven.”

- John 3:3-8: The new birth involves being born again of water and Spirit, which includes repentance, baptism in the name of Jesus for the remission of sins, and receiving the gift of the Holy Ghost With the evidence of speaking in tongues .

## *Chapter 9*

### Spiritual Warfare

- Ephesians 6:10-18: “Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.”
- Greek Word Meaning:
- Wiles (μεθοδεία, methodeia): Deceitful schemes or strategies.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4: “For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds.”
- Jude 20: “But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit.”
- 1 Corinthians 14:2-3: “For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the Spirit, he speaks mysteries. But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.”

## *Chapter 10*

### Discerning of Spirits

- We can pray and ask the Holy Ghost within us, who is the Lord Jesus Christ, to reveal to us the demon spirits at work.
  - Acts 16:16-18: Paul discerns a woman possessed with a spirit of divination (Greek: πνεῦμα Πύθωνα, pneuma Pythona).
  - Acts 13:6-12: Paul prophesies blindness upon Elymas the sorcerer.
  - Luke 13:16: “So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?”
  - Greek Word Meaning:
  - Bound (δέω, deō): To tie or fasten.
- Lossed

## *Chapter 11*

### Testimonies from the Mission Field

- Testimony #1: In a remote village in Africa, an Apostolic Pentecostal missionary encountered a woman who was tormented by a spirit of fear. After prayer and commanding the spirit to leave in Jesus’ name, she was instantly freed and filled with The Holy Ghost and fire with the evidence of speaking tongues and with joy, leading to her baptism in the name of

Jesus.

- Testimony #2: During a crusade in South America, a young man manifested violent behavior due to demonic possession. The missionary, after fasting and praying, boldly declared, “I don’t want to know your name; you’re out of here!” The young man fell to the ground and was set free, later testifying of his transformation.
- Testimony #3: An Apostolic missionary in Asia reported a miraculous deliverance of a man who had been bound by addiction for years. Through persistent prayer and the authority of Jesus’ name, the man was set free, and he now serves in the church, helping others find freedom.

## Conclusion

The ministry of casting out demons is essential in the Apostolic Pentecostal Church. By exercising the authority given to us in Jesus’ name, we can bring deliverance to those who are oppressed and bound by demonic forces.
