## THE FAITH THAT BELIEVES RECEIVES

#### 1. Faith

• Greek Word: Pistis (πίστις)

• Signifies trust, confidence, or reliance on someone or something, particularly in the context of faith in God and Jesus Christ.

2. Believe

• Greek Word: Pisteuo (πιστεύω)

• Means to have faith in, to trust, or to rely upon. It is commonly used in the context of believing in Jesus and His teachings.

#### 3. Receive

• Greek Word: Lambano (λαμβάνω)

• Means to take, accept, or receive. In the context of faith and belief, it often refers to receiving blessings, salvation, or healing.

Key Scriptures in the Gospels

Faith, Believe, and Receive

1. Mark 11:24

• "Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."

2. John 1:12

• "But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."

7. John 11:40

• "Jesus said to her, 'Did I not tell you that if you believed you would see the glory of God?'"

8. Matthew 21:22

• "And whatever you ask in prayer, you will receive, if you have faith."

#### Additional New Testament Scriptures on Faith and Belief

1. Romans 10:9-10

• "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved."

2. Acts 16:31

• "And they said, 'Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.""

6. Daniel in the Lion's Den (Daniel 6:23)

• "Then the king was exceedingly glad and commanded that Daniel be taken up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no kind of harm was found on him because he had trusted in his God."

• Daniel's faith in God led to divine protection and deliverance.

7. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego (Daniel 3:17-18)
"If this be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of your hand, O king. But if not, be it known to you, O king, that we will not serve your gods."

• Their faith led to miraculous deliverance from the fiery furnace.

8. The Israelites at Jericho (Joshua 6:20)

• "So the people shouted, and the trumpets were blown. As soon as the people heard the sound of the trumpet, they shouted a great shout, and the wall fell down flat."

• The Israelites' faith and obedience led to the miraculous victory over Jericho.
