2. The Law of Trust

- Hebrew: בָּטַח (Batach) - “to trust” or “to have confidence”
- Greek: ἐλπίς (Elpis) - “hope” or “trust”
- Scripture: Proverbs 3:5 - “Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.”

3. The Law of Action

- Hebrew: עָשָׂה (Asah) - “to do” or “to make”

4. The Law of Perseverance

- Hebrew: מַרְדָּף (Mardaf) - “to pursue” or “to chase”

5. The Law of Gratitude

- Hebrew: תּוֹדָה (Todah) - “thanksgiving” or “gratitude”
- Greek: εὐχαριστία (Eucharistia) - “thanksgiving”
- Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:18 - “Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.”

6. The Law of Intent

8. The Law of Community

- Hebrew: קהילה (Qehillah) - “assembly” or “community”
- Greek: κοινωνία (Koinonia) - “fellowship” or “community”
- Scripture: Matthew 18:20 - “For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.”

9. The Law of Reflection

- Hebrew: שׁקף (Shaqaf) - “to reflect” or “to look back”
- Greek: ἐξετάζω (Exetazō) - “to examine” or “to test”
- Scripture: 2 Corinthians 13:5 - “Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves.”

10. The Law of Hope

- Hebrew: תקווה (Tikvah) - “hope” or “expectation”
- Greek: ἐλπίς (Elpis) - “hope”

11. The Law of Purpose

- Hebrew: מטרה (Matarah) - “goal” or “purpose”

- Hebrew: אֹמֶץ (Ometz) - “courage” or “strength”
- Greek: θάρσος (Tharsos) - “courage” or “boldness”

17. The Law of Humility

- Hebrew: אָנָוָה (Anavah) - “humility”

- Hebrew: חופש (Chofesh) - “freedom”
- Greek: ἐλευθερία (Eleutheria) - “freedom”

- Hebrew: רַחֲמִים (Rachamim) - “compassion” or “empathy”
- Greek: συμπάθεια (Sympatheia) - “sympathy” or “empathy”
